

Fourth Sunday of Easter (page 269) 17th April 2016

'I know them (the sheep) and they follow me... The Father and I are one.' These are two important statements Jesus makes in today's Gospel passage from St. John. It has been suggested that the latter informs a better understanding of the former. In other words, if we can get to the heart of Jesus and the Father being one, we will then have a deeper understanding of what it means for us to be sheep known by Jesus who follow him.

If we want to know what God is like, we as Christians look to Jesus Christ. In him we see the Father's face which is compassionate, merciful, forgiving, healing, loving...the list is endless. Jesus' whole ministry is a revelation of God's reaching out to humanity created in his image and likeness. The Father is in Jesus and Jesus is in the Father. There is a mutual love which is not selfish and inward-looking but rather is poured out freely and abundantly. For us to be known by Jesus implies that he loves us intimately, that there is not anything he would not do for us and that he, as Shepherd, protects us, lays his life down for us and shares with us the new life won at Easter. He asks us as his followers to be like him - that can be so hard! Is my face radiating Christ's love? Are my hands extended to the person in need? Are my feet walking where he is directing me? What about you? We need the Holy Spirit to confirm in us Christ's image so that we in turn can come closer to him. The selfsame Spirit 'dances' between the Father and the Son and wants us to join in the rhythm! Perhaps today is a day to listen out for this still, small voice resonating in our souls and then to respond.

Today is Vocations Sunday. Some have been called to imitate Jesus in his shepherding of the flock. It is a wonderful and demanding calling - as is every vocation! We definitely need more priests. Let us pray that some of our community will hear this Divine Voice and respond.

AYLESFORD Parish Pilgrimage for the Year of Mercy to Aylesford, Kent on Saturday 14th May. Aylesford Priory, or 'The Friars' to give it its traditional name, was founded in 1242 when the first Carmelites arrived from the Holy Land. They came under the patronage of Richard de Grey, a crusader, who gave them a small piece of land at his manor of Aylesford. In 1247 the Bishop of Rochester, Richard of Wendover, officially recognised the Carmelite foundation at Aylesford and the first General Chapter of the Order outside the Holy Land was held there. Now in this Jubilee Year of Mercy 2016, we are going as pilgrims to the same place! The caoch will leave Our Lady's at 9am. There will the RosaryWay at Aylesford, picnic lunch (bring all you need!), Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Mass. We should be back by 6pm. The cost will be £10 for adults and £5 for children. PLENARY INDULGENCES a reminder about the Plenary Indulgence attached to going through the Jubilee Doors of Mercy (at Our Lady's and elsewhere). This is an extra grace which comes from recitation of the Creed, Prayers for the Pope's Intentions (Our Father, Hail Mary and Glory Be), Reception of Holy Communion and going to Confession one week before or after a visit. Pope Francis says: 'Despite being forgiven, the conflicting consequences of sin remain ... sin leaves a negative effect on the way we think and act. But the Mercy of God is stronger even than this. It becomes indulgence on the part of the Father who, through the Bride of Christ, his Church, reaches the pardoned sinner and frees him or her from every residue of sin, enabling that person to act with charity, to grow in love rather than to fall back into sin.' Remember this is not a mechanical act, it is an invitation to change and share with others the mercy experienced in encountering God. Also, the Plenary Indulgence can be applied to the Holy Souls in Purgatory or to a sick or infirm person who cannot get to church. What a great gift we can offer to others.
