
## WELWYN GARDEN CITY



Today we honour the Most Holy Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, Three Persons and yet One God. The greatest Mystery of all which is at the heart of our Christian Faith because this is how Jesus Christ revealed God to us.

There are so many ways of trying to enter more fully into this Mystery: but I think that it is the experience of God in the Mass. which is the most powerful. At the end of the Eucharistic Prayer the priest prays: 'Through him and with him and in him, O God almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honour is yours for ever and ever.' And the congregation acclaims 'Amen!'

The 'him' is Jesus Christ made known in Bread and Wine which become his Body and Blood, the outpouring of Love on Calvary and manifested in the Resurrection. Jesus helps us worship the Father. The Holy Spirit comes upon the gifts and transforms them mystically so that we are nourished by the very life of God in Jesus in the Eucharist. We are caught up in the heavenly song of the angels and saints praising God eternally. How wonderful!

The 'Amen' is our 'Yes!' to the Father and unites us with all that Jesus has done for us in response to his Father's will. This week ponder what God the Father is asking of you; reflect on how you can imitate God the Son and be more Christ-like; listen to the voice of the Holy Spirit singing in your ear, stirring up God's presence in your soul and empowering you for God's work. Then with all your might say 'Amen!'
