

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (page 83) 29th May 2016

Today is Corpus Christi! The Church gives us this opportunity to deepen our understanding and appreciation of the great mystery which is the Eucharist - Bread and Wine consecrated and becoming Christ's Body and Blood. On Maundy Thursday the Church is caught up in the drama of Holy Week and the outpouring of Love on the Cross foreshadowed at the Last Supper. This Solemnity gives us a snapshot of all that is at the heart of the Eucharist.

Cardinal Hume used to say that it is not only having an *explanation* which is important but rather an acknowledgement of the *reality*; there are many explanations but only one *reality*. This means that when we enter church and genuflect to Our Lord's Real Presence in the Tabernacle, we are making an act of faith in the One who is truly present Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity under the form of bread and wine. He has chosen to make himself known in this way and to nourish us with his very Life so that we might become part of him and he be incorporated into our lives. Our communion is with God and with others. We are in communion with the wider Catholic Church spread throughout the world and recognise the authority Christ has given the Church to establish this great Sacrament.

In recent years we have had to get used to a new translation of the Mass from Latin into English. Other countries are preparing to receive new translations soon. Even before Latin came into use, the Mass was in Greek - the original language of the Roman Empire. Christ's words would have been spoken in Aramaic. The most important language of all comes from the action of the Mass when bread is taken, broken and shared; wine is offered and drunk. Thanksgiving is offered to the Father and we proclaim anew the Resurrection of Jesus from the dead. We are caught up again in the great act of love offered on Calvary which brings us and the whole of humanity salvation.

Today let us say to God 'Thank you!' (which is literally what 'Eucharist' means) for the gift of Holy Communion. Let us pray that our love of the Eucharist may grow. Finally may our aspiration be to become more Christ-like through receiving his Body and Blood. May God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*
