

There will be tours of St. Edmund's followed by catechesis, Mass and a barbecue. Bishop Paul has asked Mike and Anita Cade from WGC to give the major input! The whole event will finish around 6pm. It would be great if many of our newly confirmed from our three parishes were able to attend.
