

WORLD YOUTH DAY The young people from WGC and the Deanery parishes had a brilliant time and prayed for you all. They are very grateful for the financial support given. The whole group will lead Mass at Our Lady's WGC on Saturday 24th September at 6pm and there will be a gathering in the Hall afterwards.

SECONDARY SCHOOL TRANSFER Fr. Norbert writes: It is important for parents to go to school open days/evenings with their children in September/October and see the options. Read the admissions criteria carefully to ensure you have a good chance of getting into the school if it is oversubscribed. Get hold of your child's Baptismal Certificate in good time. Think about the environment in which your child will flourish. In terms of the Certificate of Catholicity, the form will be given by the schools and will have to be signed by Fr. Norbert. The Certificate of Catholicity is a statement that the child comes from a practising Catholic family which means there is attendance at Mass every week. To facilitate this, Fr. Norbert will give out an 'extra' form for WGC parishes for parents to fill out for him. Meetings will be scheduled in early October when parent/s and child will come to meet with Fr. Norbert. These dates of the meetings will be published after the holidays.

Enrolment meetings: St. Bonaventure's - Friday 9th September at 6pm; Our Lady's - Tuesday 1st November at 8pm; Holy Family - Sunday 6th November after 9.30 Mass. Children should be at least in Year 3 at school.

CONFIRMATION Young people (at least in Year 9 at school) who wish to be confirmed should come with their parents to a meeting on Sunday 9th October at 7pm in Holy Family Church. Preparation starts in November.

RCIA If you are an adult who wishes to join the Catholic Church or if you are a Catholic who missed out on Confirmation when younger and now feel ready to be confirmed, come to Our Lady's Sacristy on Monday 3rd October 7.30pm. There will be a chance to meet others and find out more about what is involved.

DAY OF RECOLLECTION 'Breathe in Mercy. Breathe out Mercy' led by Bishop John Crowley, retired Bishop of Middlesbrough on Saturday 10th September for our Deanery in Our Lady's Hall, WGC. We will begin with Mass at 9.30am followed by coffee. The Day will end at 3pm. Please bring food to share at lunchtime. This Day will provide a great time of enrichment for us all but especially Catechists, Eucharistic Ministers, Readers and Welcomers. Here in WGC in our parishes we will then have the Recommissioning of Ministers the following weekend (17th/18th September) at all the Masses.

In Rome Pope Francis will close the Doors of Mercy in St. Peter's on the Solemnity of Christ the King Sunday 20th November and formally conclude the Jubilee Year of Mercy.
