'My advice is that there should be prayers offered for everyone - petitions, intercessions and thanksgiving...' These are the words of St. Paul to Timothy in our Second Reading. What are you praying for today? Who has asked you to pray for them? How does thanksgiving figure in your life as you come to Mass?

At this time of the year I am always wondering about the RCIA - the Rite of the Christian Initiation of Adults. When the first session starts, I ask my self 'Who will come through the door this evening?' Sometimes there are people who have intimated that they are interested; at other times I am surprised. One never knows and there is the possibility that no-one will turn up! We start on Monday 3rd October. The RCIA is a process whereby people interested in joining the Catholic Church can learn more, grow in faith and be strengthened in discipleship.

One of the interesting things about the Church in this country is that every weekend there are people coming who are not from a Catholic background or sometimes have not had a faith. My priest friends from Catholic countries are always staggered to discover this as I introduce them to people at Mass who are not Catholics. Some of you reading this come with your spouse to offer support and encourage your children. Some of you have come with friends or that was how it all started for you! Sometimes a chance meeting or a word offered or a feeling experienced has led to a kindling of the desire to discover more. For some of you, you are content coming to church week by week and do not want to take things further. I understand that and it's okay! But maybe there are some for whom NOW is the right time. Perhaps there is someone waiting for YOU to invite them to join the Church. There are many Catholics who were baptised and then for one reason or another were never confirmed. You are never too old to confirmed! Come to the RCIA.

My petition today is that those who are interested will be encouraged to take the first step and/or have someone else to support them. My prayer of intercession is for those who struggle with faith and never seem to find an answer which is adequate, that they may discover a trust in God who loves them so much. Finally, I am so grateful for our community with the vitality of joy and vibrancy of faith. May our enthusiasm for Christ be infectious! Have a good week and God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*

There will be a chance to meet others and find out more about what is involved.

ST. ALBANS Bishop John Sherrington will be preaching at an Ecumenical Evensong at St. Alban's Abbey Cathedral on Saturday 8th October at 4pm for this Year of Mercy. SECONDARY SCHOOL TRANSFER Fr. Norbert writes: It is important for parents to go to school open days/evenings with their children in September/October and see the options. Read the admissions criteria carefully to ensure you have a good chance of getting into the school if it is oversubscribed. Get hold of your child's Baptismal Certificate in good time. Think about the environment in which your child will flourish. In terms of the Certificate of Catholicity, the form will be given by the schools and will have to be signed by Fr. Norbert. The Certificate of Catholicity is a statement that the child comes from a practising Catholic family which means there is attendance at Mass every week. To facilitate this, Fr. Norbert will give out an 'extra' form for WGC parishes for parents to fill out for him. These can be collected from him *before or after Mass*. Meetings will be as follows: Tuesday 4th October 4 - 6pm, Monday 10th October 4 - 7pm, Friday 14th October 4 - 6pm. when parent/s and child will come to meet with Fr. Norbert at Our Lady's Church.
