Twenty-eighth Sunday of the Year 9th October 2016 p. 149 of book

'They cannot chain up God's news.' These are the words of St. Paul in his Second Letter to Timothy which form part of the Second Reading today. God's news will never be silenced as long as we are prepared to tell others about it! The 'news' is *Good* News - that of Jesus Christ - and he burst forth from the tomb on Easter Sunday breaking the bonds of death! The Gospel cannot be imprisoned if we are ready to live it out! The Gospel will radiate out from us for others to experience as we allow God's Spirit to work in us and transmit our faith through our conviction!

Who is trying to bind up God's news? In St. Paul's time it was the 'authorities' who attempted to stop the proclamation of the Good News of Jesus by imprisoning the followers of Jesus. What about now? There are some people who see religious faith as a threat to 'freedom' and regard the ways of Christians as subversive; often others can be taken in quite easily by the caricature portrayed. Sometimes fear can take hold of us and we feel powerless to share this Gospel message and life with others. Perhaps there are those who go overboard with their zeal and they put others off. Keep remembering the gift of Jesus in the power of the Spirit which sets us free from the powers that seek to destroy. Divine grace ensures that God's news is freely available!

In our Gospel reading we hear from St. Luke about the wonderful healing of ten lepers by Jesus. What is sad is that only one comes back - amazingly he is a Samaritan. 'Stand up and go on your way. Your faith has saved you.' This is how Jesus addresses the noble leper who has been cleansed. This man had been set free from infirmity. Now he can be restored to his family and religious community. A marvellous bond has been created! And all because of the faith he had in Jesus.

Let us take time this week to reflect on the words of St. Paul and co-operate with the Lord so that God's news cannot be chained up! God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*


