Thirtieth Sunday of the Year 23rd October 2016 p. 155 of book

Today we are immersed in the wonderful parable of the Pharisee and Publican/Tax-collector, which calls on us to think carefully about our attitude to prayer and our relationship to God. The Pharisee is a remarkable example of someone who does everything which is required of him by his religion. He is obviously proud of it and sadly looks down on his fellow worshipper in the Temple. To Jesus' audience it would have been unthinkable that such a paragon of virtue would not go home 'justified' - at rights with God. Similarly the Tax-collector embodies all that defines a renegade, supporting the foreign invaders, with the caricature of being a cheat. What leads him to the Temple to darken the doorway with his shadow? Why does he plead for mercy? Is he ready to change his life? He dares not look up to gaze at the wonder of being in God's House. HE is the one who goes home justified! And that is that, so far as Jesus is concerned! God's grace has triumphed and a human being is saved.

Where does this parable leave US today? It would be very easy - as with the parable of the Prodigal Son - to regard today's passage as a really good story...perhaps even to whisper to ourselves 'Thank goodness I'm not like the Pharisee'!! Am I more like the Tax-collector? Perhaps that comparison would not be as flattering! Firstly, God's grace - his Gift-in-Jesus - is available to everyone; the Kingdom proclaimed by Jesus has a place for every single person. Then the question needs to be asked: 'Am I ready to accept the invitation and respond heart, mind and soul to what the Lord asks of me?' Prayer underpins our relationship with God; our actions reveal how much we love God and allow him to inspire us. We must be honest before God. And we must be humble enough to accept that we are not perfect yet. As the Year of Mercy nears its completion, let us reflect on how we can let that mercy into our lives, like the Tax-collector...and how we can let it out by being merciful to others.
