

Thirty-first Sunday of the Year 30th October 2016 p. 158 of book

'Today salvation has come to this house...' This are the emphatic words Jesus uses to comment on all that has happened to Zacchaeus in today's Gospel. Remember that Jesus is on his way to Jerusalem; in fact, he is almost there. Even though he has his gaze fixed on his destiny in that city, nothing will prevent him from sharing with others the fruits of what will be offered on Calvary. The little man Zacchaeus, who has made pots of money for himself, climbs the sycamore tree, is spotted by Jesus, welcomes him into his home and is transformed by the experience. We hear the impatient anger of the bystanders with Jesus for going to the home of a sinner. We witness the results of Zacchaeus' conversion: paying back those he has cheated and giving a huge amount of his money to the poor. Salvation HAS come and TODAY: Zacchaeus is healed of his sinfulness through the forgiving presence of Jesus; his family receives faith as grace comes to them through Christ's salvation; the community experiences the joy of heaven as those cheated receive restitution and the poor are lavished with Zacchaeus' bounty. Salvation makes an enormous difference to so many lives and can be experienced in the here and now. Crucially the power of the Cross touches the people of Jericho and Jesus' detour to the sinner's house is not a wasted journey.

Salvation and healing go hand in hand. How do you need these in your life? The pain of misfortune, the burden of sin, the world's problems, the complications of relationships...*the list goes on!* The Lord can make a difference. As we allow his healing, saving grace into what is/has been damaged, a revolution takes place! We are changed and others too reap the benefits of the Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection. Heaven breaks into our lives here on earth NOW!
