

## First Sunday of Advent 27th November 2016 p. 82 of book

A new year in the Church's Life. A fresh entry into St. Matthew's Gospel. Our time of preparation for the Coming of Christ commences with the First Sunday of Advent. 2016 will afford us four full weeks of preparation as Christmas this year falls on a Sunday.

On the Fourth Sunday we will listen to the account of the Annunciation to St. Joseph, when the Angel tells him that Mary will give birth to a Son and that he will be called Emmanuel a name which means 'God-is-with-us' (1:23). Two-thirds of the way through the Gospel, Jesus says: 'Where two or three meet in my name, I shall be there with them' (18:20). Finally, right at the end of this Gospel, Jesus says to his disciples: 'And know that I am with you always; yes, to the end of time' (28:20). What is very clear from these three passages is that St. Matthew wants us to have the conviction that in Jesus we encounter God's loving presence and to know that Jesus is intimately with us, empowering us as his disciples. From the Baby born in Bethlehem to the Crucified and Risen One, God is with us. And in the every day, such as today as we gather for Mass, he breaks into our lives. Keep this in mind as we journey through St. Matthew's Gospel almost every Sunday of the coming year.

The message of today's passage as we embark on the Season of Advent is to be alert and ready for 'when the Son of Man comes'. Jesus will return at the end of time. In the Catholic Church our Advent begins with a wake-up call to remember that one day Jesus will return and that there will be signs and indications that this is going to happen. No one knows the exact day or hour but he is on his way. Rather than instilling fear into us, Jesus' words invite us to trust in him even more so. And so we should!

Let each of us find time this Advent to be still in God's presence and contemplate the awesome Gift offered to us by the Father in the power of the Holy Spirit. Let us pray that Jesus' Coming will enrich our lives and transform our world. God bless you.
