
WELWYN GARDEN CITY

The people John commissions to put the question to Jesus then become heralds of Good News for John. We do not hear about John's response but I can imagine that he draws hope and courage from the messengers and is then ready to meet his end as a martyr for the truth.

In our own time there are so many who are imprisoned whether actually in jail or suffering persecution. There are those who are tortured by illness, physical or mental who long for release and healing. There are people who are imprisoned by memories of the past and the pain of what they have done or what others have inflicted on them. We all know of someone who can find no answer to his or her problems and nothing we do is enough to help them. Salvation is God's gift and it can be experienced in the Person of Jesus Christ..

Do you have questions or concerns at this time? Do you think of yourself as a messenger? Is it really Good News, the Good News of Jesus Christ which you carry? What signs can you see of the Lord's presence in your own life? How is his still small voice speaking to you at the moment? Who are the people around you who this week will need to be encouraged and supported *by you*? There is much to think about today with Christmas so close. God bless you and your loved ones! *Fr.
