


## Third Sunday of the Year 22nd January 2017 p. 127 of book

Light is shining in the Galilee region, St. Matthew tells us, as Jesus begins his preaching. He cries out 'Repent!' and in no time he is gathering around him disciples and asking them in turn to 'fish' for more. It is all happening! The Kingdom of Heaven is at hand and we cannot but help see this Kingdom present in Jesus - a Kingdom embodying God's presence and radiating Divine Light. As we heard on the Fourth Sunday of Advent, Jesus is 'Emmanuel' - God-with-us. This is crucial as we now embark on a major section of St. Matthew's Gospel Sunday by Sunday. Keep remembering Emmanuel and the brilliance of his Glory.

Jesus walks along the seashore going to where people are at their daily work and normal activities. There he sees the two sets of brothers, Peter and Andrew, James and John, and asks them in turn to follow him. They are to be connected with the light of Jesus and to enter into relationship with him; their calling is to draw others to him. There is a price to pay which entails leaving everything behind - family, livelihood, familiar surroundings and security. The amazing thing is that they respond and they do so immediately! St. Matthew concludes today by telling us that Jesus goes round Galilee, presumably with these brothers in tow! They hear him and see him teaching, proclaiming and healing. What an awesome privilege that must have been for them and also a huge challenge - trying to work out the identity of this Teacher.

An important lesson for us is that Jesus is to be encountered in the everyday aspects of our lives. He comes to us and takes the initiative. He sometimes asks difficult things of us and perhaps we don't always realise the consequences of following him! In your daily life, how can you 'fish' people for him? Can you be a trustworthy witness? Do you embody the Kingdom he proclaimed? At this point in St. Matthew's Gospel, there is no mention of Church but in time Peter will be called the 'Rock' on which Jesus will build the Church. How is Jesus going to use you? And will you co-operate?!

**JULIAN OF NORWICH - MEDITATION** at St. John's Church, Monks Rise AL8 7NF on Saturday 28th January 6.30 - 7.45pm. Julian of Norwich was a woman of her time, the 14th Century, a woman who had received 16 Divine Revelations when she was about 30 years old. She spent the rest of her life, locked away in a cell - at her own choosing - reflecting on all that God had revealed to her.
