Fourth Sunday of the Year 29th January 2017 p. 130 of book

Today we climb with Jesus up a hill. We see him sit down. He then opens his mouth and begins to speak. He talks and talks and talks, putting us in touch with the Kingdom of Heaven and teaching us about true discipleship. Some of his words are affirming and inspiring; others are challenging and hard-hitting. St. Matthew gives us a picture of God-with-us teaching, preaching and drawing us closer into his life. This year we will receive five instalments and then we will be hurled into the Season of Lent!

When Moses went up Mount Sinai, he only had a few people with him. He received the Law in the form of the stone tablets and his task was to carry them down to the people as a sign of God's covenantal relationship with them. He found them busy! They were worshipping the Golden Calf which they had fashioned. The anger of Moses at the people resulted in the breaking up of the tablets and a fresh ascent of the mountain! God had to start all over again with the carving of the script. Now however, in Jesus, everyone has a chance to go up the hill/mountain with Jesus and his disciples; they all hear this Good News together.

As we listen to the Beatitudes today, picturing Jesus so close to heaven and yet caught up in intimate fellowship with people, let us ask ourselves whether we do indeed feel blessed by God in our lives. This blessing is dynamic and divine, kindles happiness and runs through the core of our being. As we gaze on Jesus, he invites us to see ourselves and others in a different way which is filled with hope, determination and courage. Jesus reveals to us the Blessed Trinity of Father, Son and Holy Spirit - God who is a dynamic and joyful relationship of 'Persons'. For Jesus to call people in different situations 'blessed/happy' means that they are being taken deep into the life of God and, in turn, being called to reach out to so many others who may not know God. Every day keep remembering how tender his love is for you and the gifts he offers you. Then share these blessings with those you encounter! Have a good week. *Fr. Norbert*
