
WELWYN GARDEN CITY



Fifth Sunday of the Year 5th February 2017 p. 133 of book

'YOU!' is a word addressed twice by Jesus to his disciples and to the crowds gathered on the hill. 'You are the salt of the earth...You are the light of the world...' What Jesus makes very clear to the people is that they *collectively* ('you' plural) are called to be an influence for good to those around them. So, as we come together today for the celebration of Mass and listen to the Word of God, we should ask the Lord to send upon us in a fresh way his Spirit to keep us united in our service and thus give glory to God the Father.

Salt was an essential for the people of Jesus' time, bringing out the flavour of food, preserving it and having healing properties. What does it mean for US to be salt? Our every day activities give us opportunities to share with others the significance Christ makes to our lives: honesty and integrity in the workplace and in the community, love and forgiveness at home and with the stranger we meet, a readiness to reach out to the person in need whom we encounter. These are some of the ways we can make a difference and make the world a better place.

At the moment with winter still with us there is much darkness. Light powerfully shows us the right path and enables us to see what we are doing. Light can illumine our faces so that we radiate faith and joy and become more aware of sadness or distress on the faces of others. If we are willing to show Christ to other people we might give them a glimpse of the Lord and spark in them faith. If others see in us as community a special quality and motivation, they might want to find out more and discover a light which takes them to the Light of the World - Jesus Christ!

Finally, just think of the image Jesus uses 'a city on a hilltop cannot be hidden'. I wonder whether Jesus was referring to the huge numbers with him on the hill and thinking of them as a city. The Church is made up of many members, living stones who point to the City of God in heaven. This light cannot be hidden; it shines out for everyone to see.
