Palm Sunday 9th April (p. 182), 16th April Easter Sunday (p. 251) and 23rd April Second Sunday of Easter (page 255)

"Go to so-and-so in the city and say... 'The Master says: My time is near.

It is at your house I am keeping Passover with my disciples.' "

These are Jesus' words at the beginning of today's Passion Reading from St. Matthew's Gospel. They have significance for each one of us as we enter Holy Week and then next Sunday embark on 50 Days of celebration of the Easter Mystery. The 'so-and-so in the city' is obviously someone known to Jesus. I cannot help but think that St. Matthew's vague way of referring to the person who will host the Passover, which becomes Jesus' Last Supper, allows each one of us to hear the Lord's invitation/command. Jesus is aware of us. We have a part to play in the unfolding of Love in the Passion and he chooses to be with us so that we intimately might be touched by this Sacrifice which brings life. 'City' which refers to Jerusalem makes me think of Welwyn Garden City! Perhaps you are going to be away with the holidays having already begun? Maybe you are planning what to do? Whatever, let not each of us forget that whichever place we are for Easter, Christ is very close and demands that we let him accompany us.

The 'time' is crucial: a period of such importance, an opportunity which cannot be missed. Jesus Christ is aware that he was sent to this earth from the Father for a purpose - his whole ministry radiated God's will. Now the completion of his work will climax in his Death and Resurrection. The Passover is the defining experience for Jews of God saving his people, remembering them in slavery and hardship, aware of their tears. God is *their* God and they know they are *his* People. Food and drink, ritual actions, taking time...all of these contribute to the Passover experience. For us as Christians, Jesus is defining us as the People of God, sharing in his salvific Death and Resurrection, stamped with the image of the Redeemer. Holy Week and Easter are a period for us to be together: individuals and families, friends and visitors - all forming Community and united with our brothers and sisters throughout the world.

So, let us commit ourselves to Christ. Let us invite him in! Let us walk with him every step of the way and be ready to taste of eternal life at Easter.

The Shrine of Our Lady at Walsingham was established in 1061 when Richeldis de Faverches prayed that she might undertake some special work in honour of Our Lady. In answer to her prayer, the Virgin Mary led her in spirit to Nazareth, showed her the house where the Annunciation occurred, and asked her to build a replica in Walsingham to serve as a perpetual memorial of the Annunciation. This Holy House was built and a religious community took charge of the foundation. Walsingham became one of the greatest Shrines in Medieval Christendom. Why not come?
