I write this piece late on Easter Sunday as I prepare to join our WGC HCPT Group 183 in Lourdes tomorrow. What a wonderfully exhausting and exhilarating time it has been! So many people - young and old, from different countries, speaking a whole host of languages and enjoying a variety of cultures - have gathered to proclaim the Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ. And now 50 Days of celebration!

The Gospel passage for today comes from St. Luke and offers us the experience of two disciples sad and dejected, leaving Jerusalem. Jesus makes himself their companion on the road though they fail to recognise him. Then he is revealed...in the Breaking of Bread. The disciples admit to themselves that their hearts burned within them as he spoke to them and they feel compelled to rejoin their friends in Jerusalem in order to share the Good News. It must have been an amazing day for all concerned as they realise that Jesus' Death was not the end and that some of them had already encountered him. Imagine the conversation as they reflect on what this 'Resurrection' really means!

We continue to meet as a Christian Community, bringing to this gathering our week with its joys and sadness, its successes and strains, its questions and answers. The Lord is here! He is listening. He is talking. He breaks Bread with us to nourish us. He asks us to go and tell others this News which has touched our own lives and can make a difference to theirs. As you think back over the days since Easter Sunday, do you have a sense of the mystery of Easter continuing to unfold in your life? What are some of the ways small or large - in which the Risen Lord has broken into your life? How would you tell the person sitting next to you in church about this?!

I will have prayed for you all at the Grotto of Lourdes and while on retreat with the Poor Clare Sisters of Arundel in Sussex. May continue to bless you and your loved ones.

WALSINGHAM PILGRIMAGE Saturday 20th May. We will be joining the National Deaf Pilgrimage to this Shrine of Our Lady. The coach will leave from Our Lady's at 8.30am. The programme for the day will include the Rosary, walking the Holy Mile, picnic lunch (so bring food and drink!) and Mass. There should be time for tea and cakes before leaving at 4.30pm. The coach should arrive back by 7pm. Price £15 for adults and £10 for children. There are signing up sheets at the back of our churches. The Shrine of Our Lady at Walsingham was established in 1061 when Richeldis de Faverches prayed that she might undertake some special work in honour of Our Lady. In answer to her prayer, the Virgin Mary led her in spirit to Nazareth, showed her the house where the Annunciation occurred, and asked her to build a replica in Walsingham to serve as a perpetual memorial of the Annunciation. This Holy House was built and a religious community took charge of the foundation. Walsingham became one of the greatest Shrines in Medieval Christendom. Why not come?
