Pentecost Sunday 4th June 2017 p. 288 of Mass book

'We never quite know what life will bring' is often what I find myself saying and how true it has proved to be. Two weeks ago I was getting ready for the Holy Land and pondering what to write in advance for the newsletter for Pentecost. In these weeks the Manchester tragedy took place, the BA cancellation of flights and my Dad's death. Nothing can take away the sadness and pain of what took place in Manchester and the horror of what a human being could do to the young and vulnerable. Our prayers are with those still recovering and those who have to come to terms with loss and permanent injury in such an unexpected way. In regard to the Holy Land, we will be trying to reschedule for later in the year but that will be an item for a future newsletter. This week we get ready for the General Election. It is so important that each of us exercises our responsibility to vote, to think and pray about who might best serve our country in all that we face locally, nationally and internationally. Let us pray that the Spirit may guide and inspire.

Today's Gospel reading provides us with the picture of the Apostles receiving the breath of Jesus' Spirit so that they can be sent out as his emissaries. Their fear is transformed into joy as they realise the Risen Lord is truly with them and peace is what he offers. In the First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles, the Apostles and Our Lady, who are joined in continuous prayer with many others, receive the promised Gift. Did they know the spectacular way the Holy Spirit would come and the dramatic effect on themselves? I don't think so! But the Church was born and her constant task is to proclaim Jesus Christ as God's Son who suffered, died and rose as the living sign of God's love for the world. This is our belief and the hope we offer - God's desire for us all to share in Jesus' Risen Life.

My Dad's death on 26th May was not expected. He obviously has been through so much in the last three years but his passing happened gently and quietly. I am so grateful to you all for the many ways you have found of showing me comfort and giving me and my family support.
