

Fifteenth Sunday of the Year to include 16th, 23rd, 30th July p. 102, 105, 108

Today and for the next two weeks, our Gospel readings from St. Matthew will take the form of parables. Huge crowds are accompanying Jesus and so he has to speak to them from a boat while they gather on the seashore. The disciples then give the Lord a metaphorical(!) nudge and ask him: 'Why do you talk to *them* in parables?' It is not a straightforward answer which they get! However, what the Lord highlights is that the parables put people in touch with the 'kingdom of heaven'. What is so challenging about the Lord's words is that he speaks about mystery, looking without seeing, listening without hearing or understanding or perceiving. Jesus then addresses the disciples and remarks that their eyes *really* see and their ears *really* hear because of Jesus himself who embodies the Kingdom. In these coming weeks as you reflect on the parables of The Sower, The Wheat and the Weeds, The Pearl of Great Price and The Fishing Net, think about your own life, what you see and hear, what mystery the Lord is opening you up to and the happiness he shares.

This week is the last for our schools before the summer holidays. May God give our children and young people a safe and happy time. May our staff who work so hard be refreshed by these coming weeks. I hope governors too can rest from their labours! May parents and grandparents looking after the youngsters have energy and patience and be rewarded with successful ways of keeping the younger ones occupied! Many of our parishioners will be going away. I wish you every blessing on your summer break. Perhaps some of you might be moving on from Welwyn Garden City and starting a new chapter in your life elsewhere. May you feel the support of your new communities and experience a happiness beyond measure. Summer is the period when new people move into the area...you are most welcome in our three parishes! SECONDARY SCHOOL TRANSFER Time is racing by and parents will be thinking about a secondary school for their children soon to be in Year 6. Fr. Norbert always suggests to parents to visit the different schools with their children. An open morning allows you to see the school in action and the way the pupils and staff are. Think about where your child will flourish, taking into account his/her gifts, travelling, friendship groups and what schools offer. Definitely read the admissions criteria and try to see whether or not your child has a good chance of getting in. Some Catholic schools will need a Certificate of Catholicity which implies weekly attendance at Mass. Fr. Norbert will be available in the autumn to sign these certificates. All Catholic schools will need a Baptismal Certificate, so now is a good time to request one if you have not got the original. If the Baptism was here in Welwyn Garden City, contact Kathryn Hubbard (01707 322579); otherwise make sure you give yourself time to acquire one from the church of Baptism. Should you need any other help, speak to Fr. Norbert or ask at school.
