
WELWYN GARDEN CITY



Twenty-sixth Sunday of the Year 1st October 2017 p. 134 of Mass book

In today's Gospel passage, Jesus confronts his audience with another challenging parable. It is especially targeted at religious people who *say* they will do the right thing and *do not* and the 'sinners' they despise who obviously have not had the time to anything right and yet are bowled over by the message of Jesus, come to their senses and then live out what God really wants. Jesus knows just how provocative his words are as he asks the religious to take a leaf out of the books of the wrong-doers who change their ways.

Words or actions...which do you regard as the more important? In our Catholic Christian Faith, it is easy to say all the right things to keep someone else happy - a priest, a parent, a spouse, God(!). What is far more important is that the words are put into practice. That's the hard part but it really does give authenticity to the words uttered. Humility to admit we've done wrong is another characteristic of the repentant sinner and should result in a godly way of life. If our connection with Christ is only superficial, people will be able to see through us in time. If we are Christ-centred, the more and more they get to know us, the deeper they should fall in love with Christ through their encountering him in us. Sunday Mass is crucial for our identity as Catholics but this Catholic life must overflow into our everyday words and actions.

Soon we are going to be starting up again the RCIA when adults are invited to find out more about faith in Jesus and take the steps which might lead them to become full members of the Church. I have met in recent weeks a number of you who have expressed an interest. I have also confronted some of you with an invitation to come and see! For those of you already fully immersed in the life of the Catholic Church, just think: is there anyone you know who would love to find out more, someone waiting for that personal invitation (and support) which could change their lives? Now is YOUR chance! Now is THEIR opportunity! God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*

SECONDARY SCHOOL TRANSFER Fr. Norbert urges parents to visit the different schools with their children. An open morning allows you to see the school in action and the way the pupils and staff are. Think about where your child will flourish, taking into account his/her gifts, travelling, friendship groups and what schools offer. Definitely read the admissions criteria and try to see whether or not your child has a good chance of getting in. All Catholic schools will need a Baptismal Certificate, so now is a good time to request one if you have not got the original. If the Baptism was here in Welwyn Garden City, contact Kathryn Hubbard (01707 322579); otherwise make sure you give yourself time to acquire one from the church of Baptism. Some Catholic schools will need a Certificate of Catholic-ity which implies weekly attendance at Mass. Fr. Norbert will be available to sign these certificates as follows: Monday 9th October 4.30 - 6.30pm and Tuesday 17th October 4.30 - 6.30pm. Please contact Kathryn Hubbard to book an appointment. Parents and children should come together and wait in Our Lady's Church. Fr. Norbert will call you when ready. There is an 'extra form' for parents to fill out before they come to give Fr. Norbert details of Baptism etc. Please make sure you collect one from the back of our churches.
