

We are now back in Ordinary Time and the Church this Sunday gives us a passage from St. John's Gospel. John the Baptist is carrying out his role of putting people in touch with the Christ; Jesus is beginning his ministry and gathering his first disciples. So much is happening at an amazing speed! What I especially love about today's excerpt is that the two disciples spend a day with Jesus. It is always worth revisiting this notion in our daily lives.

Each day, how do you spend time with the Lord? Is there quiet and stillness? Are you surrounded by frenetic activity? Is it hard to find an opportunity or a place solely to be with Jesus? Obviously through our responsibilities, work, those entrusted to us we can discover Christ. However, finding that extra moment to listen, to intercede, to ponder, to say 'Thank you!' is vital as followers of Jesus Christ. Maybe a resolution for 2018 might be to create a personal and profound moment which opens us up to God's grace and a peace which fills us with serenity. This isn't just wishful thinking! It can become a reality.

The other aspect of today's Gospel reading which I often reflect on is what it must have been like to witness Jesus at work. Imagine seeing him with the sick, the outcast, braving the hostility of his opponents. Picture him at prayer or spending quality time with family or friends. Soon after today's passage the Lord is in Cana and works his first sign, changing water into wine and calling so many to faith and an experience of God's glory. What do you think he was like at the wedding feast? Did he look as if he was enjoying himself? What did his face look like as Mary pointed out that they had run out of wine? Amazing! Our joy and responsibility is to let our actions and words be signs of Christ's presence, to radiate something extra in life which is suffused with the divine. He knows we can do it and calls us to be his family and his instruments!
