

In today's passage from St. Mark, Jesus begins his ministry with the words: 'The time has come...the Kingdom of God is close at hand.' What do you make of these words? Time implies NOW and connotes an opportunity to be seized. Do you feel like doing anything right this moment? Could Jesus change your life? What does he really ask of you? What is this Kingdom, this Reign of God? The power of the Kingdom is its presence in Jesus Christ! Does this make you feel good - that as he comes closer to you, the Kingdom is made known? Do you regard yourself as an instrument co-operating with the Lord or do you find yourself being an obstacle at times to his Kingdom? 'Repent and believe the Good News' comes next from the Lord's lips...quite technical language! Repentance is a complete re-orientation of one's life, learning to direct oneself towards God. Jesus asks us to believe, to enter into a relationship which involves mind, heart and soul - one's whole being. And it is focused on a message which is Good News - Jesus himself is the Good News. Is this what you really think and are willing to live out? We then turn to the calling of the first disciples; they are two sets of brothers who are fishermen. 'Follow me' is heeded immediately by these men. No questions are asked, no strings attached, a huge cost involved. There is something about Jesus which is magnetic and charismatic that they listen and respond with everything. Was it easier for them because they encountered the Lord face to face, hearing his voice and experiencing his presence? They were not the only ones to follow; so many were drawn to the Kingdom by Jesus Christ, enriched by his dying and rising and willing to make that total commitment. They are the very people who formed the community for which St. Mark wrote and they in their turn handed on this Good News. In our day, Jesus continues to call many to follow him. He and our world need the witness of Christians. Our handing on of this Good News allows another generation to come to life in the Lord. Let us renew our
