

Third Sunday of Lent 4th March 2018 page 154 of the Mass Book

Today's Gospel reading is from St. John. We are now in the Temple with Jesus early on in his ministry and we witness the 'cleansing' of God's House as Jesus throws out the money-changers and pigeon-sellers. There ensues a conversation with his protagonists which results in two remarkable points: the Evangelist tells us that the 'sanctuary' Jesus speaks of is his body which is the true Temple, home of the Living God and that after the Resurrection they realise the veracity of his word. Secondly, St. John comments that 'Jesus knew them all and did not trust himself to them... He could tell what a man had in him.'

Let us reflect on this passage. Jesus refers to himself as *the* Temple. He is a living building in which we can encounter God and spend time with him, learning from his words and actions. The huge Sacrifice of Good Friday is the offering made in this Temple and indeed sums up what happens in the Eucharist. After the Temple is destroyed, it is rebuilt in three days. The Lord points to his being lifted on the Cross at the end of the Gospel and ultimately the power of Resurrection which will shine out - a rebuilding of the Temple. Jesus understands each person; he is able to read minds and hearts. The crowd around him in the Temple is made up of various people: his disciples, the religious leaders, pilgrims and ordinary folk carrying out their religious observances. Christ's motivation and inspiration come from the Father; he is the one Jesus trusts. What does it mean for you to understand that the Lord knows what you have in you - what you are like? Do you feel uncomfortable? Are you relieved that God's Son knows you through and through? Are you willing to let him cleanse you of all that comes between you and true worship of God? Surely this is what Lent is about as we allow God to do some spring cleaning in our lives?! It takes real trust and a humility to admit what gets in the way and respond.
