

'I am the Good Shepherd.' These are the powerful words of Jesus uttered in our Gospel passage from St. John. Easter probably seems a long time ago and after the freezing weather, the warmth and sunshine of this week have brought smiles to so many people's faces. Think back to the mystery of Easter. How did it impact on you in your life this year with the particular joys and sorrows, burdens and worries you experience? The Good Shepherd knows us intimately: our names and our histories. He is ready to guide us and to impart to us knowledge of the Father who sent him to be with us. As Shepherd he understands us as sheep because he is the Lamb who was sacrificed for the salvation of the world. He truly is good as he was ready to lay down his life in obedience to the Father for saints and sinners, for those who know him and those yet to discover him. What a gift to us from God our Father! And more importantly as he shares life with us we are helped *to become like him!*

In the first week of Easter I had the joy of going to Lourdes with our local HCPT Group 183. We prayed hard for you, the people of Welwyn Garden City; we are grateful for your generosity in supporting Group 183. We lit candles at the Grotto for your intentions. The power of faith, the vitality of the young - and not so young - helpers, and the happiness of the children we accompanied gave me a real boost!
