

'I have loved you...I call you friends...I chose you...' These are snippets of what Jesus says to his disciples at the Last Supper in St. John's Gospel. Think of your own life and unite yourself with the Lord. Allow the full import of his words to sink in and then consider what action is required!

Firstly, he has loved us. Wow! Obviously that might kindle warm feelings within. However, this kind of love is rooted in the reality of our lives. Jesus shared in our joys and our sorrows, times of acceptance and moments of rejection. And yet, he did not give up because his love for us is so powerfully available. This huge desire to do what is best for us led him to the Cross and his love is victorious!

Secondly, he counts each one us as his friend. He wants to talk to us personally. He listens - and really listens - as we speak to him from the heart. He takes us as we are; though it is likely that as he spends time with us we begin to take on a likeness to him! He walks by our side carrying our burdens for us. He teaches us the true value of friendship enabling us to grow in friendship with each other.

Thirdly, he has chosen us! What does he see in you? What have you done which has caught his notice? What plan does he have for you so that you begin to wonder why he has chosen you? How will he equip you for the future and the unfolding of his dream for you? Sometimes this is so obvious...at other times you are left wondering 'Why me?'!

What is going to be your response? Judas left the table to betray him. Peter denied three times that he knew him. So many, apart from the Beloved Disciple, scattered. What about you? Let us pray for the courage to love as he has loved, to keep his commandments, to be filled with his joy! God bless your week ahead. *Fr. Norbert*
