

Seventh Sunday of Easter 13th May 2018 page 273 of the Mass Book

Last Thursday we celebrated the Ascension of the Lord, the first time in many years that the Catholic Church in this country celebrated it on the 40th Day of Eastertide. That means that today's Mass is the Seventh Sunday of Easter with an excerpt from Chapter 17 of St. John's Gospel - Jesus' Prayer to the Father. This chapter concludes the Lord's long discourse at the Last Supper in St. John and is followed by his journey with the disciples across the Kidron Valley to a garden where he is arrested. Jesus prays to his Father for US! He wants us to be one as he is one with the Father. He asks his Father to protect us. He implores the Father to consecrate us in the truth. He is so aware that his Mission came from the Father to be sent into the world; and in the same way he sends us out too. Jesus looks back, he speaks about the present and is aware of the future; he also is caught up in eternity.

When we celebrate Mass, we share in Jesus' offering of himself to the Father. The love poured out on Calvary has its source in the relationship of the Father's love for the Son and the Son's total obedience and love for the Father. By remembering the events of the Lord's Passion, Death and Resurrection in the context of the calling to mind what he did at the Last Supper, Jesus allows us to be drawn into the Mystery of a love beyond measure which is the bond of Father, Son and Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit quietly, gently and yet firmly embeds Divine Love within us just as he filled Jesus' life and transforms the bread and wine of the Eucharist into Christ's Body and Blood. The Spirit creates unity, consecrates us and takes us up into eternity!

We have one more week to go until we complete our celebration of Easter with Pentecost. This is a time of intense prayer for the outpouring of Jesus' Gift from the Father - the Holy Spirit. Why not model your prayer on Jesus' words? Reflect on what he wants for us and let our desire be to be as open as possible to what he prays for us to his Father. Then, by next Sunday, we will be ready to be 'zapped' by the Holy Spirit and be sent out like the Apostles on a mission to proclaim boldly the Good News of Jesus Christ. God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*
