
# WELWYN GARDEN CITY



Eleventh Sunday of the Year 17th June 2018 page 95 of the Mass

Last week I mentioned that Welwyn Hatfield Council had given planning permission for the demolition of Our Lady's Hall/Family Centre and the building of a new Parish Centre for our three churches. Quite a number of years ago, before the Growing in Faith Project was launched in Welwyn Garden City, time was spent reviewing the state of the present hall, the ways it functions and the possibility of a new centre to serve the whole of our community. Together with the three chairs of our Finance Committees, I met with the Financial Secretary of the Diocese and the Diocesan Surveyor and we were encouraged to proceed. There have been open Parish Meetings to look at the plans and the various options, an architect was chosen. NOW it is the next important step! I have to write to the Trustees of the Diocese formally to request that we go ahead and to seek a loan which will support the whole project. I have to describe (again) the process and show that we would be able to pay off a loan. My application to the Trustees must be in by 24th June for a 26th June meeting. Otherwise the next meeting will be in September - time which would be lost. My hope is that we could demolish in October and have the new Centre ready by November 2019.

The cost of the new Parish Centre will be roughly £750,000. The money coming back to us from Growing in Faith will be approximately £242,581. This latter projected sum will your generous contributions from five years of giving which will conclude next year. This means that we will need a loan of about £500,000; hopefully we can pay it off over 10 years. I have met again with the three chairs of our Finance Committees and they agree with me that the best way of raising the funds will be through money which is pledged. WGC has pledged £543,442 to GiF over five years, thus supporting Diocesan Charities. Some of you may want to stop for all sorts of reasons; some may be happy to continue your generous giving and thus support the new Parish Centre; there are still others who perhaps might like to help with this project. Growing in Faith will have a clear end. A new system of giving would have to be formalised. There may be some of you would like to make one-off donations and leave it at that. With Growing in Faith - and offertory collections in general - I do not know what people generously give and I have never made it my business to find out. Obviously, if individuals would like to commit themselves to a large donation, it would help me to know at an early stage so that the scope of the loan would be more realistic - less in effect!

Personally I don't like talking about money a lot of the time - the proclaiming of the Gospel is my passion! However, if this project can be completed with the loan paid off, this will relieve the pressure/worry and be a worthy gathering place for so many: parishioners, local groups and be a source of outreach to those in need. It will be a great legacy for you - our people - as this Garden City enters its Centenary Year in 2020. God bless you and have a wonderful week. *Fr. Norbert*
