


Today's Gospel passage from St. Mark is such a sad one! Jesus goes home and what sort of welcome does he receive? People are not happy with him because they feel they already know who he is; there is nothing more to discover. He finds very little faith and so is unable to work many miracles. What an impact this must have had on him. I wonder how often, when he went about his ministry, did he think back to this situation?

This passage is a real challenge to us who are his followers. It is all too easy to think that we know everything there is to know and are not open to something fresh, someone new, which/who might enlighten us with the wisdom and experience of faith. Perhaps we can find ourselves wanting to hear only the bits that we want and not be ready to 'accept' all that the Lord is offering us?

The other challenge which arises from this account is in our attitude to others, those we know and the stranger or the newcomer who chances upon us. Do we allow stereotypes to form our approach to people? Do we stick with our own group? Are we ready to let a freshness permeate the tried-and-trusted? Jesus has a wonderful way of reaching out to the marginalised and of building bridges. Can we reflect him?

Finally, the 'lack of faith' is an interesting turn of phrase. I am sure the people of his hometown would have been scandalised to hear that they have 'little faith'! 'Who does he think he is?' could well have been their attitude. Faith entails yearning for more, acknowledging that there is still something else to discover AND having the humility to accept that God can choose the most unusual ways of enlightening us!

This week reflect on this passage and on people you encounter. Think back to Jesus' experience in his hometown and see if there is a lesson you can learn which will help you in the situations you face. God bless you. *Fr. Norbert*
