

Do you know the fairy tale which has the words: 'Mirror, mirror on the wall, who's the fairest of them all?'? The evil Queen puts this question to her magic mirror every morning as she looks at herself. And, of course, the answer is always: 'You are!' until Snow White appears on the scene. The rest of the story unfolds...

In our Gospel reading today from St. Mark, the disciples are arguing not about 'the fairest' but about 'the greatest'! We are not told who wins the competition! It really does seem so strange that the followers of Jesus, now in Galilee where they had experienced the Lord's calling, and hearing Jesus' second prediction of his Death and Resurrection, can only focus on themselves. As they look figuratively at themselves in the mirror they are absorbed in who they are and their achievements. Christ offers them a vision of the Suffering Servant, the Son of Man delivered into the hands of men. To reinforce the imagery he then sets before them an innocent child who for him is the paradigm of greatness because, in welcoming a child, Jesus insists, his disciples will be welcoming him and, in turn, the One who sent him - God our Father! Jesus' huge sacrifice and the power of Divine Love revealed in him is no fairy tale! At the heart of our Faith is the reality of God who is so close to us and who wants everyone to be saved. This God has planted in us a seed of life and his only desire is that we should water it, nurture it and let it bear fruit for eternity.

I am sure that you will be looking at yourself in the mirror many times this week. Stare hard and look for signs of Christ. See if the revelation of the Father's love for you is being revealed. Reflect on whether those you are encountering are having a glimpse of greatness! Then give glory to God! If things are not turning out as you expect, don't worry. Make a fresh start buoyed up with the healing, forgiving grace which emanates from the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ. Have a good and fruitful week!

OPEN PARISH MEETING 55 people attended last Tuesday's meeting. Minutes will be available in due course. Our thanks to all who contributed to the discussions as well as those who gave presentations. There was plenty to think about and actions which will be required. The financial accounts of our three parishes are now at the back of each church.

The Family Centre has played a huge part in the life of the Catholic Community and the Town. Many socialised there when they came to the Garden City. A large number met their spouses there and their children made lifelong friends in the Centre. For others it served as a venue for Wedding Receptions and Funeral Receptions. There have been dances, pantomimes, concerts and plays. A huge amount of charitable work and fundraising has taken place. Our thanks to Fr. Michael Groarke for his vision all those years ago and to the priests and committee members who have given of themselves to serve the wider Community. In recent years there has been the Pomegranate Café and many social occasions flowing from the celebration of Mass. To mark the completion of this chapter, there will be a Get-together in the Lounge on Saturday 6th October after 6pm Mass. Please bring food to share. Those coming are invited to bring photos and mementos and thus have a chance to catch up with others and give thanks to God for all the blessings received.

SECONDARY SCHOOL TRANSFER Fr. Norbert urges parent/s to visit Secondary Schools with their child and to reflect on which school will help their child flourish. For those applying to Catholic Schools a Certificate of Catholicity is required which affirms that a child comes from a practising Catholic family, i.e. a family which attends Mass every week. It is crucial to read a school's admissions policy to see if your child has a good chance of getting in. Fr. Norbert will be available in October to sign the Certificate of Catholicity Forms: Wednesday 10th 4.00 - 6.00pm, Monday 15th 4.00 - 6.30pm and Tuesday 23rd 4.00 - 6.30pm. Please make an appointment with Kathryn Hubbard for a 10-minute slot. Parent/s and child should come to Our Lady's Church and wait to be called. In due course there will be the 'extra' form at the back of our churches which will need to be filled and brought to the meeting.

Pray. Talk to another Catholic. Come to Church and deepen your experience of being with others.
