
WELWYN GARDEN CITY



Thirty-second Sunday of the Year 11th November page 155 of the Mass Book Today Armistice Day and Remembrance Sunday are one! Today is the Centenary of the ending of the First World War. In our Gospel reading we are given - by Jesus - a glimpse of the widow who gave everything. Very soon...and he will go to his Cross!

100 years on all we can do is marvel at the willingness of the soldiers to give their lives for the sake of freedom and peace. They obviously thought it was going to be a quick venture, but the toll of casualties, huge suffering and trauma left their mark during the time of war and in subsequent years. Families were affected in myriads of ways. Peoples were displaced. International boundaries changed. A period of uncertainty! The war graves at home and abroad bear testimony to the heroic witness of so many and the human cost in families torn apart by bereavement and injury. Let us pray for healing, reconciliation and peace. A Second World War followed and we know that even know in a variety of countries troops risk their lives to safeguard justice and peace. Let us pray for them too and their families.

Let us ponder the widow of the Gospel. A forgotten person in the eyes of society, she is ready to offer to God all she has, trusting in him. (With our 21st Century eyes we can think of many reasons why this might not have been such a prudent thing to do!) What is wonderful about Jesus Christ our Saviour is that he notices even the lowliest, he understands her and he commends her. As he prepares for his Passion, he will have in his mind this lady who in God's House - the Temple - is ready to sacrifice everything. On the Altar of the Cross, Jesus too will give to his Father his whole being so that we might be saved. Pure love motivates him and he will not let anything or anyone stop him from embarking on the course he has begun. He definitely wants us one day to be with him in Heaven!

As we begin another week of remembering in this month of November, let us reflect on the word 'sacrifice'. How can we make our lives living sacrifices of praise to God's glory? There are many examples to emulate. Let us do something!
