

## Feast of Christ the King 25th November page 160 of the Mass Book

'Who is this Jesus?' is a question asked in the Scriptures and perhaps one we often reflect on ourselves. In our Gospel passage today, we move to St. John's Gospel and witness the encounter between Jesus and Pontius Pilate. The latter embodies the political powers of this world; the former who is a King not of this world. The latter who is keen to save Jesus and yet falls a victim to the pressures of so many around him. Jesus regards himself solely as a witness, one who has a mission which he faithfully carries out and who is ready to use his voice to speak the truth; he wants humanity to listen to him.

Let us spend a moment considering when Jesus is referred to as king or his kingdom is mentioned in the Fourth Gospel. In John 1:43-51, Nathaniel is brought to Jesus by Philip. Jesus is able to tell Nathaniel what he was doing when Philip found him and Nathaniel cries out to Jesus: 'Rabbi, you are the Son of God, you are the King of Israel' which leads Jesus to say that Nathaniel will see the 'angels of God ascending and descending' above the Son of Man. In John 3:1-8, Nicodemus - a Pharisee and a leading Jew - comes to Jesus at night and hears Jesus saying to him '...unless a man is born from above, he cannot see the kingdom of God...unless a man is born through water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God...' Finally, when Jesus is lifted upon the Cross in 19:19, Pilate has a notice attached to the Cross 'Jesus the Nazarene, King of the Jews' (INRI). In John 6:15, after Jesus has fed the 5000, the people want to take Jesus by force and make him king - this kind of king they want to liberate them from (political) oppression. Jesus escapes into the hills and, I am sure, communes with his Father - his kingship is not of this kind.

So, who is this Jesus, especially in terms of kingship? He is our link with heaven. His kingdom is not one we would expect here on earth. He is a king nailed to the Cross who brings us salvation. Take time today on the Solemnity of Christ the King to think about your picture of Jesus, reflect on whether you need to modify/deepen your understanding, and pray that, through the gifts he offers you, you may be one with him in his kingdom eternally.
