

Third Sunday of the Year 27th January page 130 of the Mass Book

Today we return to St. Luke's Gospel and are with Jesus as he goes home to Nazareth. Jesus is in the habit of going to the synagogue and no-one is worried when he is asked to read from the scroll of the prophet Isaiah. It is as if Jesus arrives knowing which passage he is going to choose and the excerpt forms a programme of what he intends his ministry to be. Here - and in so many points in this Gospel - the Spirit is at work and empowers Jesus and others to prophesy or give praise to God. In the Acts of the Apostles which is St. Luke's account of the Early Church, the same is the case: the Spirit seizes hold of the disciples and numerous others and, by forming Church, the Good News of Jesus is proclaimed, lived out and experienced. The people gathered in Nazareth fix their eyes on Jesus and he wins their approval as he announces that the Scripture is being fulfilled as they listen. Wait until next Sunday!

'The Spirit of the Lord is upon me' is how Jesus begins his quote. Think back to the Lord's Baptism with the Dove coming upon him as he prayed and the Father's voice calling him the 'Beloved Son'. Consider that Mary was told at the Annunciation that the Child would be conceived through the Holy Spirit. Just before today's passage, Jesus was led into the desert by the Spirit to be tempted by the devil. Christ is aware of the poor, the downtrodden, captives, the blind - in short those desperate to receive 'Good News'. A Year of Jubilee is what he offers as he cites the centuries-old words of Isaiah. Jesus' audience receive this Good News not only through words but in person; the renewal and refreshment of 'Jubilee' are for now and into eternity. The townsfolk have heard about all that Jesus has been doing. Perhaps they are now waiting with baited breath for something more?

This week let us pray that this same Spirit of Jesus may flood us with love and grace, the energy to reveal Christ to those we encounter. May the words we use and the way we are in action reveal the reality of the Good News of God's Son in our midst. God bless you.

NEW PARISH CENTRE The Trustees of the Diocese have given the go-ahead for the building of the new Parish Centre to serve our three parishes and have approved a loan of £350k over 12 years at 1.9%. We will be receiving £252k from your generous giving through Growing in Faith (GiF). Soon Fr. Norbert will be forming a Fundraising Committee to raise monies to pay off the loan. We found through GiF that pledged giving really does realise funds in a substantial way and also make the possibility of paying off the loan realistic. GiF for WGC will conclude this summer. Some of you may wish to stop your giving; others continue in a fresh way. Perhaps some were not involved before or are new to the parish. Please do think about it. The Architects have put the project out to tender and soon there will be a tender meeting to choose a contractor. It is possible that demolition might start by Easter! This would mean the new Parish Centre being ready in Welwyn Garden City's Centenary Year. In regard to the possibility of the three parishes becoming one 'canonical parish', conversations have begun and there will be time and opportunities for information to be shared with the pros and cons to be outlined. There will be consultation and a chance for opinions to be expressed.

PRESENTATION OF THE LORD will be celebrated on Saturday 2nd February with 10am Mass at St. Bonaventure's and 6pm Mass at Our Lady's (which will be regarded as a 'Sunday Mass'). Candles will be blessed and carried in procession on this 40th Day after Christmas to remind us of Jesus 'The Light of the Nations'.

HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL DAY is today (Sunday 27th) and remembers the six million Jews murdered during the Holocaust, the millions of people killed under Nazi Persecution and in subsequent genocides in Cambodia, Rwanda, Bosnia and Darfur. 27th January marks the anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz-Birkenau, the largest Nazi death camp.

There will be a unique event 09:30 - 11:30 - Hawthorne Theatre followed by a Civic Memorial Service outdoors at The Campus West Arena delivered in partnership by Welwyn Hatfield Borough Council, The Welwyn Hatfield Interfaith Group and our local secondary schools. Doors open at 09:00am. Refreshments will be served in Campus West Terrace Suite at 11.30am where you will have the opportunity to browse an exhibition of a range of themed art pieces and written work created by local young people.
