

A new month has begun, the snow has fallen AND soon it will be Valentine's Day!!! Is this the reason why St. Paul's 'Hymn on Love' is one of the Scriptures set which may be read at some of the Masses today. Chapter 13 of St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians (or a part of it) is often chosen by couples getting married probably because of the sentiments expressed and, I guess, as the word 'love' is mentioned so many times. I know that on many retreats, people are asked to replace 'love' with their own names and reflect on whether the statements can be applied to themselves or to put Jesus' name into the equation and come to a realisation of the power of love which he reveals.

All of this is good and instructive but it might help to consider the Epistle as a whole, especially starting from the beginning. St. Paul is very upset with this community because of the factions which have formed, the taking of sides and the slogans being used. St. Paul chastises the Corinthians because Christ is being lost in the midst of their arguments. The Apostle then turns to the state of morals - anything seems to go and he feels the need to upbraid these people he knows so well. He reminds the congregation of the Gift handed on to him which he in turn has passed on to them—namely the Eucharist. He does so in order to hold them to account for neglecting to feed the hungry of the community and having a hierarchy of places to sit at the assembly. Then there is the issue of the different gifts of the Spirit which lead some to think they are better than others. This too has led to disharmony. It does sound quite disastrous!! It is in this context that Love is proclaimed: the Love radiated by Jesus Christ, especially on the Cross, and Love which forms community, overcomes barriers, unites bringing harmony. This Love does not come to an end but takes us to the eternal Love of God in heaven from where it has come down on earth and been made incarnate. This is what Paul wants the community in Corinth to learn, experience and share. What a challenge to us too!

I invite you to take a moment this week to read and reread Chapter 13 of First Corinthians. Let each of us reflect on our personal way of living and how we affect relationships at home, school, work or in the community. Through the power of God's Word and in the Holy Spirit, let us ask for the help we need to let Christ's Love be our inspiration and joy, forming us into individuals who create harmony and peace to the glory of God.

MARRIAGE PREPARATION Any couples wishing to get married in Welwyn Garden City or elsewhere this year or in 2020 should speak to Fr. Norbert so that the necessary preparations can be made. This 'Day' gives couples a chance to step back from the usual organisation of the Wedding Day and to focus on themselves and their relationship. They have serious, privileged experience of getting ready for a lifetime of Marriage as well as the fun and enrichment of being with other couples in the same boat.

**SIGNED MASS** Shell Roca, Director of the Deaf Service of the Diocese will be coming to help with the signing of Mass on Saturday 30th March at 6pm at Our Lady's. There will be two 'practice' sessions to prepare on Tuesdays 19th and 26th March at 7.45pm for an hour in the Sacristy of Our Lady's. Those who took part in the Deaf Awareness Course should let Fr. Norbert know if they can come. Others too may come to these sessions but the maximum number for a fruitful session would be 16 people.

NEW PARISH CENTRE The Trustees of the Diocese have given the go-ahead for the building of the new Parish Centre to serve our three parishes and have approved a loan of £350k over 12 years at 1.9%. We will be receiving £252k from your generous giving through Growing in Faith (GiF). Soon Fr. Norbert will be forming a Fundraising Committee to raise monies to pay off the loan. We found through GiF that pledged giving really does realise funds in a substantial way and also make the possibility of paying off the loan realistic. GiF for WGC will conclude this summer. Some of you may wish to stop your giving; others continue in a fresh way. Perhaps some were not involved before or are new to the parish. Please do think about it. The Architects have put the project out to tender and soon there will be a tender meeting to choose a contractor. It is possible that demolition might start by Easter! This would mean the new Parish Centre being ready in Welwyn Garden City's Centenary Year. In regard to the possibility of the three parishes becoming one 'canonical parish', conversations have begun and there will be time and opportunities for information to be shared with the pros and cons to be outlined. There will be consultation and a chance for opinions to be expressed.
