
# WELWYN GARDEN CITY

As you read this newsletter 40 of us will be embarking on the walk - Camino - to Santiago de Compostela along the Portuguese route from Tui. There is a special passport issued to pilgrims who manage 100km and so the journey will be this length with stamps attached at various points along the road. I have twice visited Santiago but never on foot! It will be challenging but very fulfilling. So many on this pilgrimage are coming because it is on their bucket-list of things they want to do in life. I am sure you have seen the television programmes and films about the Camino. Walking and talking, silence and prayer, togetherness and solitude, eating and drinking, sleeping and then more walking...! Pilgrimage brings people together and is life-changing. Pilgrims carry many intentions in their hearts. YOU are in mine and I will be thinking of you every step of the way. The great Cathedral of Santiago is the destination with its massive thurible - the botafumeiro. Unfortunately there is restoration work going on so it might not all be as we expect. Please keep us in your prayers too.

In our Second reading for this Sunday from the Book of the Apocalypse, we are giving an incredible vision of the holy city - Jerusalem. It is so beautiful and is illumined by the glory of God and the Lamb is a torch for it. John the Elder is in effect saying to us with confidence: 'This is how it will be' - absolutely amazing! Can you picture yourself in the image? How is God's grace perfecting you, preparing you for the ultimate encounter with him? Is there anything possible for you to do to get you more ready to enter the New Jerusalem? In our Gospel reading from St. John's Last Supper account, Jesus speaks to his friends about love - given and received; he offers them peace which is that well-being rooted in God's presence. Why not ask for these gifts today?

**THY KINGDOM COME** This is a global network initiated by the Archbishops of Canterbury and York a few years ago. Christian Churches across the world join in continuous prayer from the Ascension (30th May) with Our Lady and the disciples waiting for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost (9th June). Our desire is that people at home and abroad come to know Jesus Christ. In Hertfordshire and Bedfordshire, leaders from the Methodist, Baptist, Free, Catholic, Pentecostal, Eastern and Oriental Churches have signalled their support. The launch event will be at the Coptic Orthodox Cathedral in Stevenage on Thursday 30th May. Every day afterwards at St. Albans Cathedral there will be prayer at 8pm in the Lady Chapel following different styles of worship/liturgy including Taize and *ex tempore* prayer. On Friday 31st Monsignor Harry Turner (who often helps in Welwyn Garden City) will lead prayer before the Blessed Sacrament (Adoration). There will be a Beacon Celebration at St. Albans on Sunday 9th June at 6.30pm to which everyone is invited.

**ASCENSION DAY** this year will be on Thursday 30th May. It is a Holy Day of Obligation when the Church asks Catholics to attend Mass. The Masses will be as follows: 9.30am at Holy Family, 12 noon at St. Bonaventure's and 7pm at Our Lady's.

**FIRST COMMUNIONS** Our Lady's 9th June at 11.30am and St. Bonaventure's 16th June at 10.30am.

**FINANCE COMMITTEES** Holy Family's on Wednesday 12th June at 7.30pm and Our Lady's on Wednesday 17th July at 7.30pm. Every few years there is an internal audit of each parish by the Diocese. Ours will take place over the first three weeks of June. Fr. Norbert is very grateful to the parishioners who are preparing all the documentation!
