

Pentecost Sunday 9th June page 294 of the Mass Book

After Jesus ascends to heaven, St. Luke tells us in the Acts of the Apostles that the disciples gather, pray and wait for what Jesus has promised. Then it all happens on the Fiftieth Day! There is noise - a powerful wind from heaven filling the entire house. There are tongues of fire which settle on the head of each one. They speak in foreign languages about the marvels of God AND they are understood! The Promise of Jesus is his Spirit and the Spirit fills them with his presence. They are transformed! The Church is born as an active community which reaches out with the Good News of the marvels of God - surely the Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ, his Ascension to the glory of the Father's Right Hand and - now - the outpouring of pure Gift. Just as Our Lady conceived through the power of the Holy Spirit and gave birth to the Son of God, so now individuals who spent time with the Lord are moulded into a community which is Spirit-filled and cannot help but proclaim what they have heard and seen - with boldness and conviction.

For us this is such an important day, not a one-off feast but the completion of all we have celebrated since Easter Sunday. We too have spent time with the Lord. He has shared with us many experiences and offered words of hope and promise. NOW he pours out on us the Spirit to renew us and to renew the face of the earth. He needs our voices to announce Good News to others; he wants our lives confidently to live out this message; he empowers us so that our hearts may be aflame with love for God and our neighbour. WE ARE TO BE CHURCH! That's not easy all the time! As with the first Pentecost, people might misunderstand us or question our motivation. However, remember we are carrying out his will and his desire is that no one should miss out on the heralding of Good News. So why wait? There's a job to be done!

CAMINO Fr. Norbert writes: The 40 or so pilgrims returned exhausted but elated from the 100km trek to Santiago de Compostela. Everyone made it including me! The terrain was challenging with steep climbs, stony obstacles and temperatures rising to 36C. Walking and talking, silence and the contemplation of the wonder of creation, mutual support and encouragement, the discovery of new things, places and people - these were some of the hallmarks of the Camino. Those who got there first formed a welcome party to shout, cheer and applaud the pilgrims as they arrived. I know for myself that I felt ecstatic completing the long journey and experiencing the huge sense of achievement. Of course, there were the blisters, the fatigue, the dehydration. However, I prayed for YOU each day and carried you all in my rucksack! For those interested, the Feast of St. James (25th July) falls in 2021 on a Sunday so the whole year is declared a Holy Year. The restoration of the huge Cathedral is preparing for that year of celebration. Perhaps you might want to walk then? The pilgrims will have a reunion on Saturday 20th July after 6pm Mass at Our Lady's.
