

Trinity Sunday 16th June page 81 of the Mass Book

This Sunday and next we have Solemnities which highlight great mysteries of our faith. Today the focus is on honouring the Most Holy Trinity and next week, we will move to the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ - the Eucharist. These celebrations prompt us into deep thinking! However, we must not remain solely at the level of the head, but move to the heart and our lives. I will make a number of statements and then reflect on their import for us.

God is a Trinity of Persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. God is One and God is Three. God has always existed; that is what it means for God to be God. God has chosen to create all that is and the stamp of the Creator is to be found in what we see and hear. Indeed science reveals to us the complexity of Creation and the amazing Mind behind it. There has been a point in time when the Second Person of the Trinity took flesh in the womb of Mary, thus entering time and space. The Trinity has remained as Trinity; Jesus Christ is God and Man. How this has been possible and the explanations are many; the facts are laid before us.

In becoming one of us, God shows us the high nature of humanity - that God can be found in this way. Jesus Christ is leading us to God; so our destiny is the eternal life of God and his Son makes it possible. Here on earth, we have a taste of heaven, of love which is Divine and we glimpse in Jesus the nobility of our state. When we love, we are tapping into the source of love which is God the Father and we are blessed. When we are loved, God breaks into our lives with a treasure beyond compare. Just think about the God's freedom to fashion us in his image and likeness and his desire that we should live close to him for ever. In sacrifice, forgiveness, selflessness and care, we are caught up in the Divine and love blossoms. Just think what the experience for eternity might be like! Ponder these thoughts today as you listen to - and read - the Scriptures and feel God's blessing!
