

Corpus Christi 23rd June page 83 of the Mass Book

When I think of Corpus Christi, my first memory goes back to when I was five years old, a child at Primary School and a Corpus Christi Procession in the grounds of the convent. We followed the Blessed Sacrament singing. I remember the sun was shining! Times change and the convent has a new location and probably the procession doesn't happen any more. However, the memory and the experience have stayed with me.

In our Gospel passage today, St. Luke's community calls to mind the fact that Jesus fed the 5000 with just five loaves and two fish. In thinking back to this event, they must have associated it with the Eucharist: Jesus raising his eyes to heaven, blessing and breaking, then getting the disciples to distribute the loaves and the fishes so that the crowds could eat as much as they wanted. In our reading from St. Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians, he reminds his community of what he received and handed on to them. St. Paul gives us the words used by Jesus at the Last Supper when the Lord promised that the bread and wine, blessed and consecrated truly would become himself - his Body and Blood.

In today's Solemnity, the Church invites us to remember - and give thanks - for the Gift beyond measure which nourishes us with the Lord's very life. This Sacrificial Banquet helps us to worship God our Father and gives us the sustenance we need to grow more and more like Christ. The Eucharist brings healing, forgiveness and is the Food of everlasting life. Mass can be celebrated in a small room or chapel, in the magnificent splendour of a cathedral or outdoors with the open sky as a ceiling. It is the same Lord who nourished the crowds who makes himself known in this heavenly way. In having Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, we can adore the Real Presence and rest in his love. In participating in a Eucharistic Procession, we follow Jesus and learn from him about selflessness and total giving.

May today's celebration enable each one us to grow closer to Jesus Christ and strengthen our appreciation of the Gift handed on to us. God bless you! *Fr. Norbert*
