"Martha, Martha...!"This is how we hear Jesus speaking to his host in today's comical passage from St. Luke. The Lord stops off on his journey to be with two sisters, Martha and Mary; each serves Christ as she knows best. For Martha, her desperation to please the Lord results in her fretting, taking over and having a go at Jesus for her sister's lack of help. Where is Mary? Sitting at Jesus' feet listening! And Jesus tells Martha that "It is Mary who has chosen the better part." How did that leave Martha feeling? What was Mary's response? We will never know. However, the power of the scene is revealed in our lives as we try to heed the voice of Jesus.

I know that this passage can provoke individuals into taking sides - for Martha, for Mary; people can be left unhappy with the failure of Jesus to appreciate the hard work of Martha. Nevertheless, think back to last weekend's passage from St. Luke: the lawyer was told by the Lord to "go and do the same yourself", to be like the Good Samaritan in showing love to one's neighbour. Here Martha is told to model her life on Mary by having an attentive ear and a posture open to him. We definitely need time to be intimately close to God's Son, the Word. Stillness and silence which are so hard to come by in our time, can draw us into an experience of life filled with blessings. St. Luke does not share with us a word from Mary - she seems to be lost in contemplation!

As we enter the holiday season, what can we learn from these two sisters? Is there time each day to be close to the Lord in prayer, silence, the Mass or in creation? How does Jesus through his Spirit want to recharge your batteries? What are the jobs you have put off for a long time and now is the right moment to set to work and carry them out? There is so much love God is lavishing upon us - in and through his Son; there is a huge response in love we can make to God - through his Son.
