

Twenty-ninth Sunday of the Year 20th October page 152 of Mass Book

"...the need to pray continually and never lose heart." Today's parable which follows addresses those who need encouragement in prayer. Why did St. Luke feel he had to recall this story from the Lord? What was going on in his community? Perhaps the people thought that the Kingdom should have come by now and wondered at the delay? Was persecution making life unbearable for them, making them despondent? How does this parable to speak to us as individuals in our particular circumstances?

Often we have found ourselves praying non-stop for someone else, for a special intention in an unselfish way - and yet nothing has happened. I'm sure we have asked ourselves 'Where is God?' when we place in his hands the suffering and oppressed. It is hard. There is no answer. We feel it's not fair. Jesus says to us: 'Don't stop! Persevere!' Does that help? Maybe we should remember the many times in St. Luke where we see Jesus praying so intensely and none more so than in Gethsemane where the scene in this Gospel is of sweat pouring off his face like drops of blood. His words to his Father at that time are: 'Father, if you are willing, take this cup away from me. Nevertheless, let your will be done, not mine.' Then he goes to his Passion. As we journey through the complications (and the joys) of life, we need to let Jesus accompany us just as we try so hard to walk with him. He wants us to draw strength from him and to realise we are not completely on our own. The challenge is, while not having the ability to understand everything completely in a divine way, to carry on patiently, lovingly and confidently. We will be vindicated by God is the message of the parable. Next weekend's parable will further our grasp of how God regards prayer.

Have a good week. Pray for your personal needs. Let's not forget our country at this crucial time in our history. Our world too matters to God; let us intercede for it.
