

Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe 24th November page 167

We come today to the last Sunday of November and the final Sunday of the Church's Year when we celebrate Christ the King. November certainly has been a month of remembering! Our Gospel passage today from St. Luke takes us to the Cross and the scene which unfolds as Jesus is executed. One of the thieves dying with Jesus taunts him and scornfully tells Christ to save himself and the two dying with him. The other pleads: 'Jesus, remember me when you come into your Kingdom'. What a powerful, humble prayer which acknowledges faith in Jesus! The Lord's response: 'Today you will be with me in paradise' highlights his own faith in his Father who will raise him to glory when he pours out his life in his last breath and that this gift of eternal life will be shared with others. Jesus does indeed save the latter who is open to what Jesus can do for him. Can you recall the final words of Jesus in his encounter with Zacchaeus which we heard not so long ago? 'The Son of Man has come to seek out and save what was lost'. We can see and hear this in the Good Thief's conversation with Jesus!

So, as the Liturgical Year draws to a close, we are put in touch with Christ's Kingship: on the Cross, suffering intensely and saving the lost one who turns to him with trust. Next weekend, with the start of Advent, our Scriptures will move from St. Luke to St. Matthew - still 'Gospel' but with different perspectives and challenges. Each Evangelist held on tightly to the message of Good News proclaimed but found ways of sharing it with a fresh outlook for the communities they served and wrote for. In these important moments in our own country's history, let each of us pray that God's Kingdom may come with justice, peace, harmony and hope. Let us reflect on Scripture each day. Let us try to be instruments of the Reign of God so that those around us may have a taste of the love which Jesus Christ brings into our world.

ADVENT During the Season of Advent which begins next weekend there will be times of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament in each of our churches: Mondays at Our Lady's, Thursdays at Holy Family and Fridays at St. Bonaventure's all 10.00 -10.30am. The Service of Reconciliation will be on Tuesday 17th December at 8pm in Our Lady's.
