## The Presentation of the Lord 2nd February page 297 of Mass book

Today is the 40th day after Christmas! We celebrate the Presentation of the Lord - Candlemas. Many countries still have the tradition of leaving their cribs, trees and decorations out until this Feast. In our Gospel reading from St. Luke we are reminded of Mary and Joseph's journey to Jerusalem to fulfil the requirements of the Law and their encounter with Simeon and Anna. The significance of the old man, Simeon, calling the baby 'The Light of the Nations' has led to the custom of the Blessing of Candles and Procession with them at the start of Mass. Jesus is the Light of the World and the Light of our lives! Anna is a sign to us of the constancy and perseverance of an 84-year old who comes by at just the right moment and is not afraid to tell others about Jesus. Can we do the same?

Our celebration this day invites us to reflect personally on the qualities of the 'light' which Jesus brings: direction, hope, wisdom, communion, a glimpse of eternity, forgiveness, salvation, redemption...the list goes on! A candle burns itself up in order to produce warmth and light - it is sacrificial. Through the candles we hold today we are put in touch with the One who will give up his life for the sake of humanity. Simeon is certain that Our Lady will have a share in the suffering of the Cross with her heart being pierced with a sword. Surely we can learn from today's Feast about what Jesus does for us AND what it is possible and necessary for us to do to radiate his presence to others?

In our land we have entered a new era with the dawn of Brexit. For many there has been huge relief and rejoicing, for others confusion and sadness. Let us allow Candlemas to fill us with the Light of Christ: Christ to be enjoyed as Lord and Saviour, Christ to be shared with others as Friend and God's Son.

A final word. I have just returned from Hungary where I spent a week with Daniel Voros who was with us last July. He is still so full of joy at his wonderful experience of being in our midst; people I met knew all about it! I had the opportunity to meet the Bishop of Szombathely (in the west), to celebrate Mass in English in a secondary school and to concelebrate Mass in Hungarian - an amazing time. He sends prayers and regards to our parishes. Have a brilliant week.
