
WELWYN GARDEN CITY



'I have seen the miserable state of my people...I have heard their appeal to be free...Yes, I am well aware of their sufferings...' These are the words of the Lord spoken to Moses when the latter encounters God in the Burning Bush in today's First Reading. God chooses Moses to be the leader to guide the people out of Egypt. He commissions him to speak to Pharoah. God reveals his name as the One who is pure Being. The journey begins and the hope of Exodus. When I read these words, I thought of how they reflect our feelings for the people of Ukraine, desperate to be set free and relieved of suffering, determined to have their own land and the separation which has ensued as so many have had to flee.

Last Saturday evening our Vigil of Prayer was so powerful and yet highlighted our helplessness. We were in solidarity with the suffering and with each another; we were one in the Lord. I would like to thank the parishioners and friends who came and enriched each hour with music, song, reading, prayer, refreshments and silence. We know we can't do everything on our own and at such times calling on God's Name and engaging in deep prayer is essential. So many want to help materially, through fundraising and by offering hospitality in their homes. For the people of Israel escaping from Egypt, it was a long and complicated road. In the present situation there are no easy answers or wands which can work magic. Nevertheless, let us continue to pray and intercede, to support and reach out with help, to let the prospect of a solution offer hope and light in the midst of so much uncertainty.

As we walk the path of Lent, the Lord wants with all his heart for us to turn back to him completely. He asks us to work hard to bear rich fruit in our lives. He offers eternity in the glory of heaven and the Cross is the means.

There will be reflection on Scripture for about 10 minutes and then 3 visiting priests will join Fr. Norbert and Fr. William to hear Confessions. There's time to stop, think and ponder, time to make your Confession and experience the riches of God's mercy in this sacramental way AND the opportunity to go to a priest you do not know (if you prefer)! People leave once they have gone to the priest for Confession. Put the date in your diary. Parents bring your children. Let's avail of this moment in Holy Week to feel the closeness of the Lord to us in the Sacrament of Reconciliation.
