

Christ the King 20th November 2022

FIRST CONFESSION & FIRST HOLY COMMUNION There will be an enrolment meeting for parents and children from St. Bonaventure, Holy Family and Our Lady's on Tuesday 22nd November at 6pm in Our Lady's Church. The meeting should last around 40 minutes and dates will be given for the preparation and the First Holy Communions which will be celebrated in all three churches. Children should be at least in Year 3 at school.

CONFIRMATION Enrolment for young people for Confirmation will be on Sunday 27th November at 7pm in Holy Family Church. Bishop Paul McAleenan has given us Friday 9th June 2023 as the date for Confirmation here in Welwyn Garden City. Young people need to be at least in Year 9 at school and should come with their parent/s to the meeting which will last around 40 minutes. Dates for preparation will be given that day.

RCIA The Rite of the Christian Initiation of Adults for adults who would like to join the Catholic Church will next meet on Monday 21st November at 7.30pm in the Sacristy of Our Lady's. This is also a great way for adults, who missed out on Confirmation when they were younger, to prepare for Confirmation. In some countries you cannot get married in the Catholic Church if not confirmed. The meeting will last an hour.

Cereals, long life milk, squash, jam, tea, coffee, toilet rolls, washing up liquid, bleach, clothes washing products, toiletries (shampoo, deodorant), kitchen and bathroom cleaner, ladies' sanitary items, toothbrushes & toothpaste and in the run up to Christmas anything Christmassy to bring joy to families.
