On the 13th July, Jesus said to the lawyer after giving him the parable of The Good Samaritan: 'You go, and do likewise.' On the 20th, Martha is told that her sister, Mary, has chosen the good portion by sitting at the Lord's feet and listening to his teaching. On the 27th, we are given the picture of Jesus praying in a certain place and the request of a disciple: 'Lord, teach us to pray...' We are given The Lord's Prayer. With the summer weeks upon us, how do we get it right in our relationship with the Lord and with others? We should be active in serving those in need. We must not neglect time spent in company with Jesus, learning from his words. We have to find ways of being icons of Christ whose intense love of the God the Father inspired his prayer and his determination always to do good. Perhaps the summer will allow you to explore fresh ways of praying? Singing or reciting the Rosary as you walk? At the end of the day, reflecting on one or two moments when you felt God's presence breaking into your life? Pondering when things went wrong and trying to learn lessons from the event? Opening the Bible and thinking about what God is saying to you? Silence...the serenity of contemplation? Allow the Lord to teach you as he taught his disciples! On the 3rd August, the Gospel passage speaks of a dispute over inheritance and leads to a parable from Jesus about a rich person who has plenty and says to himself: '...relax, eat, drink and be merry.' Jesus is insistent that we should be rich towards God. How can we do this in the reality of our lives? Our true treasure is the destiny of God's Kingdom, experienced here on earth but reaching fruition in heaven. My thanks to everyone who works so hard to enrich our lives in our churches. To those going away, have a great time. To visitors, welcome! To those staying here, be refreshed!
